

# What can I expect to learn?

-  **Climate Change in RI** How climate change works, the impacts to your community, and the need to plan for resilience.
-  **Flooding** Flooding scenarios in Rhode Island, the social and economic impacts of flooding, as well as flood mitigation examples, opportunities, and programs.
-  **Infrastructure** Impacts of climate change on infrastructure, the vulnerability assessments available, and how to use State assessments to inform local plans and actions.
-  **Stormwater** How a changing climate impacts stormwater; how low impact development and green infrastructure techniques can be used to avoid, reduce, and manage impacts.
-  **Mapping Tools** The various mapping tools available for assessing flood risk, planning, and making informed decisions.
-  **Adaptation** Site-based strategies to address the various implications of climate change; how to integrate adaptation and hazard mitigation strategies into local planning.
